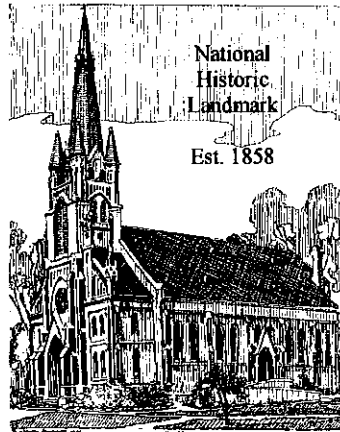

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is an approach to the religious formation of children that is rooted in the bible, liturgy of the church, and the educational principles of Maria Montessori. Children gather in an "atrium", a room prepared especially for them, where they can come to know Jesus, the Good Shepherd. The atrium contains simple, yet beautiful materials that children use to help them absorb the most essential proclamations of the Christian faith. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a sensorially rich experience for children from ages 3 – 12 years that gives them the opportunity to grow in their love and knowledge of God.

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd religious formation is being implemented in our parish and school. As part of this program, an Atrium is required for each site. The atrium is a place of prayer, in which work and study spontaneously become meditation, contemplation and prayer. The atrium is a place in which the only Teacher is Christ; both children and adults place themselves in a listening stance before his Word and seek to penetrate the mystery of the liturgical celebration.

Reminder: The Postures of Mass

Standing is a sign of respect and honor. When we stand for prayer, we are assuming our stature before God as a people redeemed by the blood of Christ. We stand when the celebrant and other ministers process into the church. We stand for the Gospel because we acknowledge that it is Christ Himself speaking to us when it is proclaimed.

Kneeling signified penitence in the early church: the awareness of our sins casts us to the ground! In the Middle Ages, kneeling came to signify the homage of a vassal before his liege lord. More recently, kneeling has come to signify humble adoration.

Sitting is the posture of attentive listening and meditation. The assembly sits for readings before the Gospel and the homily, and may also sit for a period of meditation after Communion.
